I place on record the contribution and encouragement that your goodself had rendered to bring various laurels to our University in this year.



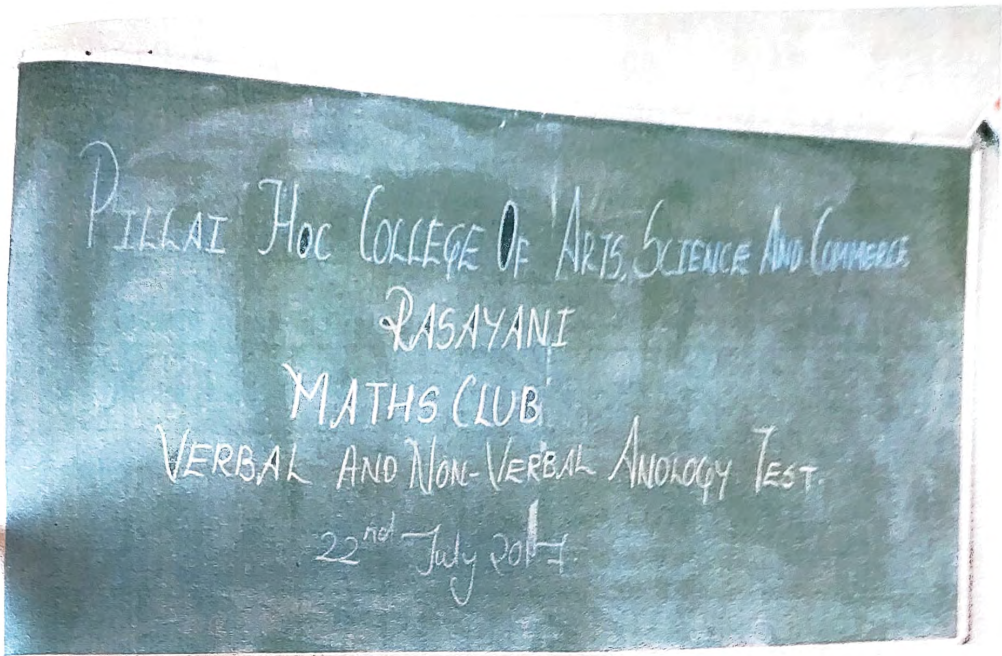
