Report:-	<p>Cinema reflects society. Watching a film on the big screen stimulates a rush of myriad emotions. In a time when the issue of gender equality is becoming increasingly relevant, a film festival exclusively showcased movies on the theme on 6th February 2020.</p> <p>The Department of Arts (BAMMC) visited Sambhav Film Festival to watch series of short films on Gender, Masculinity and Relationships. The festival at Bhausahab Nene College was open to all, but had largely a student audience. Total 76 students from BAMMC of our college visited this college. The films screened led to discussions on subjects often ignored by mainstream films - including same sex relationships, transgenders and prejudice.</p> <p>The film festival hosted movies from a bunch of renowned filmmakers.</p> <p>Dishant Soni has directed the film ‘Wave’, which highlights the bystanders in gender-biased violence on women. The film narrates the story of a young girl who is inhumanly ignored by society while facing sexual assault amid a heavy traffic jam.</p> <p>Mitali Trivedi from Delhi has directed the film ‘Please mind the gap’, which narrates the story of a transgender who is continuously reminded by the society that they fall nowhere between the spectrum of man and woman. This story touched heart of many of us.</p> <p>Lalita Krishna, who has directed a documentary titled ‘Untying the Knot’, is about chronicles of the life of a domestic violence survivor.</p> <p>Aditya Jambhale’s national award-winning film ‘Kharvas’ was also screened. Kharvas narrates the pain and trauma of a mother who gives birth to a stillborn child.</p> <p>Vibha Bakshi’s ‘Son Rise’ offers a glimpse into the patriarchy-ridden society of Haryana, which has also won the national award recently. This film is about ordinary men from the interiors of Haryana, who are actually fighting for equality and women’s rights.</p>

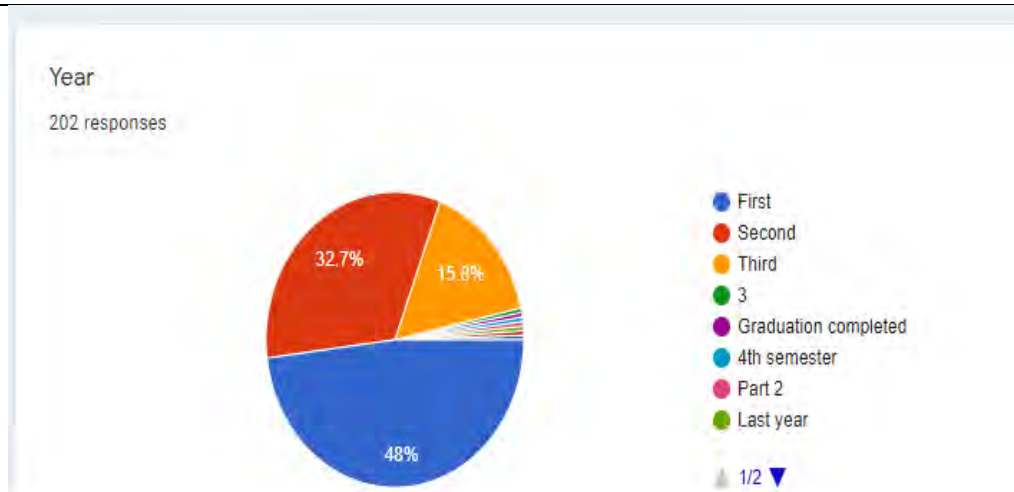
Response Graph with States

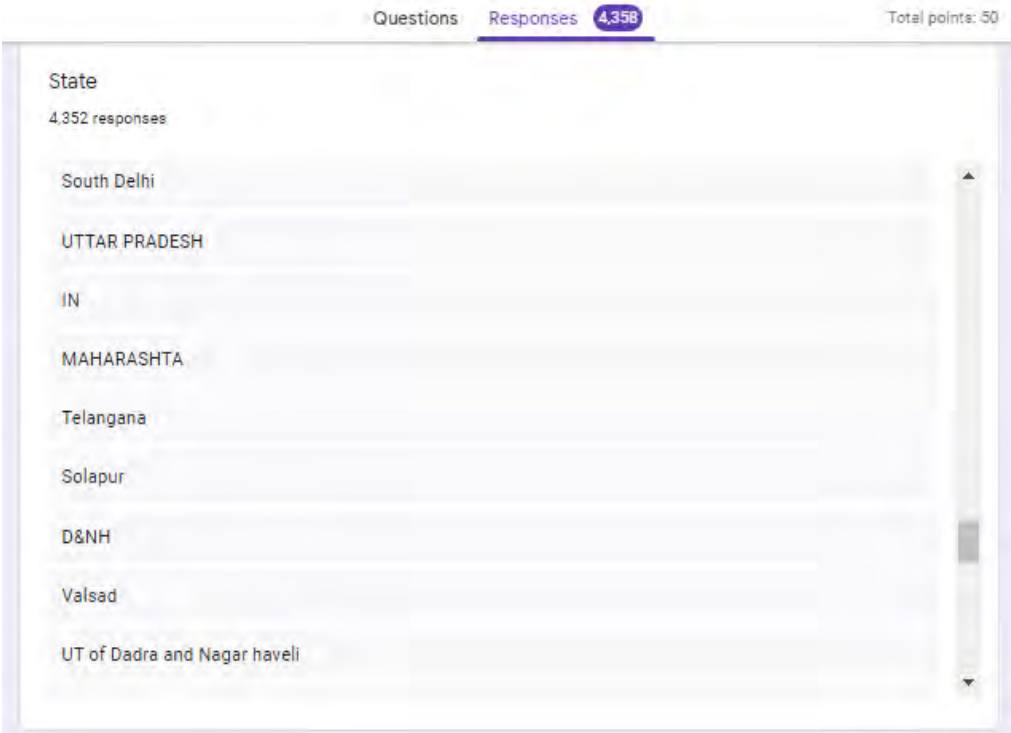
After the successful completion of the event, students were given refreshments. The performances were enthralling and engaging till the end. The event turned out to be one of the most memorable and successful event.

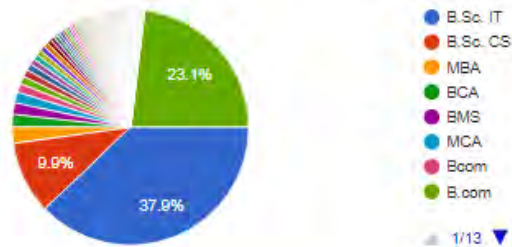

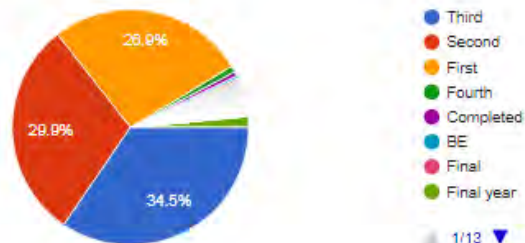

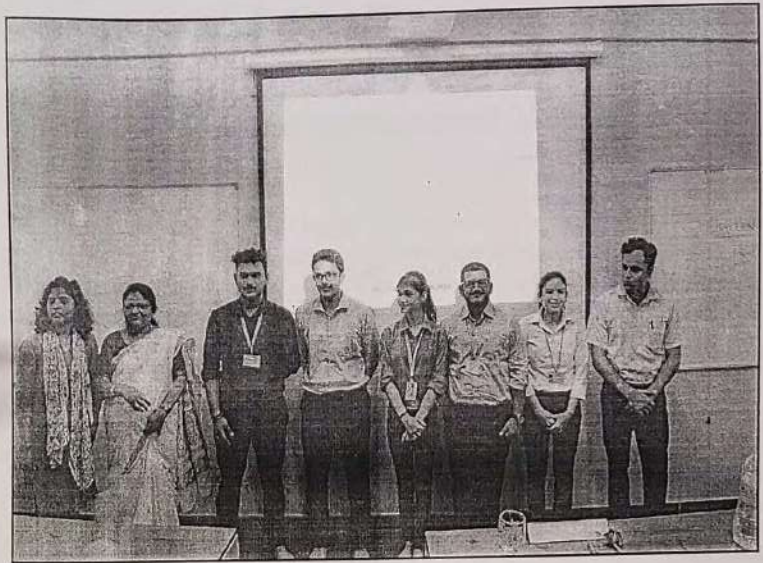
The topic for the Elocution Competition was **Reforming National Health Policy**.
