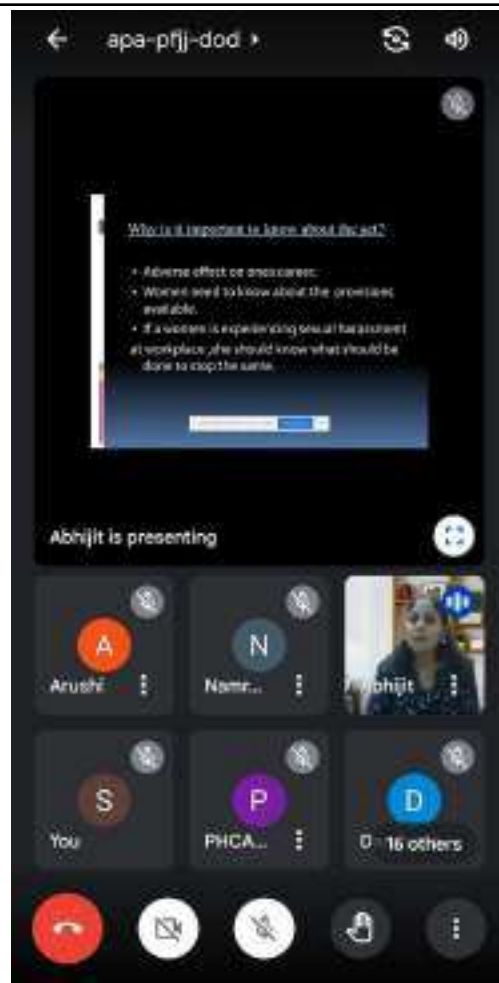
Convention (CEDAW), Bhavari Devi case, Vishakha guidelines, etc.

Self-care strategies such as good sleep hygiene, maintaining a nutritional diet, exercising regularly, reducing weekly caffeine as well as a few relaxation routines were also discussed in the session.

on Cyber Security in association with Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) exclusively for female staff members and students of our college to promote cyber wellness and create awareness on Cybercrime against women. Online Platform for the event was Google Meet. A total of **236** participants attended the same.

The guests of honour for the said event were introduced by Prof. Disha Chotaliya which was followed by the opening remark by Prof. Remya Madan Gopal. The speakers of the event were:

- 1. Ms. Sonali Patankar, Founder, Ahaan Foundation.**
- 2. Mr. Unmesh Joshi, Co-Founder, Ahaan Foundation.**

The Webinar was divided into two sessions. The first one was taken by Ms. Sonali Patankar, whereas the second session was taken by Mr. Unmesh Joshi.

First session:

Ms. Sonali Patankar talked about how the social media platform is used by many specifically the pros and cons. She highlighted the several Cybercrimes committed against women such as Fake profile, Hacking, Stalking, Morphing, Cyber bullying, Cyber terrorism so on and so forth. She intimated the students about a professional hacker course which could be done after graduation and also spoke about the several complications in cyberspace with relevant examples. She spoke about, Morphing and how it could be used against another person on the internet. She shed light on Bullying and how it is raging on social media platforms. She spoke about various things which should be kept in mind when it comes to Cyber bullying like acceptance, content identification, never destroy evidence, never respond to Bullying, reporting of Bullying. She enlightened the participants with several other frauds like financial frauds. Certain tips were shared with the participants to ensure that they never fall under any such trap. She alerted the audience about the several Anti-social groups on social media and how to stay away from it as being a part of the said group could lead to undesired consequences. A lot of information about online gaming and the importance of choosing the right sort of game were also mentioned. A tip to stay away from online gaming addiction was also shared. She spoke in length about the excessive use of electronic devices(pros and cons), Selfie consequence(how it becomes an obsession), Proper use of the hashtag, Consequences of virtual relationships and pornography content, Raising voice against objectionable content and the need to keep digital footprints clean.

Second session:

Mr. Unmesh Joshi addressed the participants for the second session. He spoke about URL verification and the need to investigate the news items before forwarding. In this age, where fake news has become rampant, it is always important to cross-verify before sharing anything online. He spoke about social media sites and how auto-downloading of images should be disabled. Certain security tips like Mobile Antivirus, Updation of the operating system, Secured wifi routers, changing the password frequently and parental control settings were provided to the participants. Mr. Unmesh spoke about social media safety settings, the

importance of reporting fake accounts and the importance of reading the terms and conditions before downloading any app. He spoke on length about the laws of cyber security, discussed various sections, the nature of the crime and the punishment of the crime. The various steps to be taken in case of a crisis were discussed. The need for responsible online behaviour was also put forward. Finally, Sir addressed the queries of all the students in a Q & A session which was followed by the vote of thanks by Prof. Disha Chotaliya. The feedback link was shared with the attendees.

Taking into consideration the contribution of women during COVID Pandemic and the theme of UN Women – “Women in leadership: Achieving an equal future in COVID-19 world”, Women Development Cell (WDC) and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Pillai HOC College of Arts, Science & Commerce, Rasayani, in collaboration with Soroptimist Welfare Association (SIBC) jointly organized a Panel Discussion and Short Film Screening on March 08, 2021, on account of International Women’s Day – Women on the frontline against Covid-19 . Soroptimist members from all over the world had joined the session.

A total of **140** participants attended the same.

The guests of honour for the said event were introduced by Prof. Linu George, which was followed by an introduction of SIBC by Ms. Preeti Pawar.

Session 1:

We conducted a panel discussion with women who are still on essential duties to cope with the COVID pandemic situation. To engage the audience, the format of interaction was a panel discussion where one student – Ms. Hiba Irfan asked questions, and the speakers responded accordingly.

Following were the speakers of the event:

1. Dr. Deepali Jadhav, B.H.M.S.

Dr Deepali Jadhav spoke about the experience she had and the challenges she faced at the initial stage when the COVID virus had started spreading rapidly. She also spoke about the ways the COVID pandemic has contributed to the problem of physician burnout and as a physician how they handled the misinformation which were spreading on social media regarding vaccinations and treatment of COVID-19. Lastly, she told us the benefits of an antibody test and the procedure to adopt in case of home quarantine.

2. Ms. Rouble Negi, Social Activist- Founder of Rouble Nagi Art Foundation

Ms. Rouble Negi shared her experience of helping people in the COVID-19 situation; she told us how social activists played a crucial role in the COVID -19 pandemic. She also spoke in length about how the thought of helping others in this pandemic came to her mind and how she was never worried that by helping others her family may suffer, as they were supportive of her. Lastly, she spoke about the challenges she faced while helping people and also how she and her team were able to spread the correct information about the diseases and the precaution that needed to be taken.

3. Ms. Sonali Tukaram Kadam , Sub-divisional Officer – Alibaug, Raigad.

Ms. Sonali Tukaram Kadam started by informing us how she and her team convinced people about the seriousness of the pandemic and the challenges she faced during the COVID-19 pandemic in India. She told us the additional precautions the law enforcement personnel were required to take during the death investigation and also what sort of additional precautions they took while they returned home from work. Ma'am, also informed us on how they helped the migrant workers since they were the worst sufferers.

Session 2:

After the interaction session, a 16 min feature short film created by our students (FYBAF & FYBMM), was screened to pay tribute to all the women who played an important role in the COVID situation.

After both the session few Soroptimist International members from Greater London and Plymouth spoke a few words of gratitude for inviting them for the event and also shared their experiences with the other members.

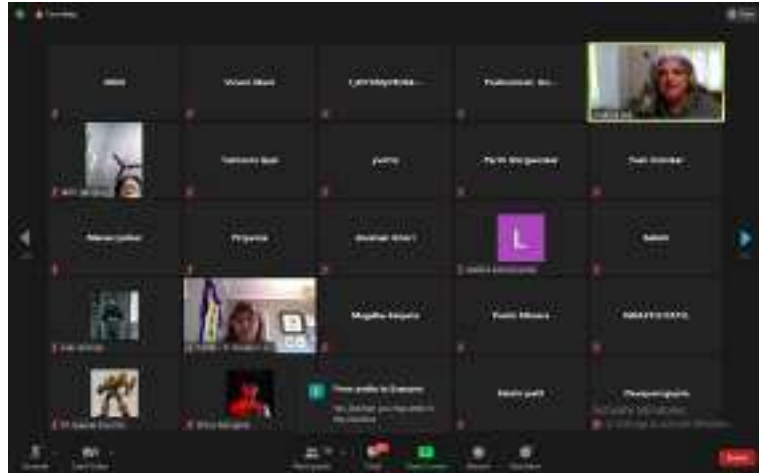

The pattern of seeds within a Sunflower follows the Fibonacci sequence.



The sunflower seed pattern used in the Museum of Mathematics contains many Fibonacci numbers.

Fibonacci also laid the ground for a modern-day mathematical understanding of certain shapes in nature, including Nautilus shells.



Spiders weave structures together making sheets, tangled, and funnel webs. The Fibonacci sequence is used in the design of these webs.

For the web to be strengthened and also remain flexible, the Fibonacci sequence is used to accommodate growth and the potential web.
