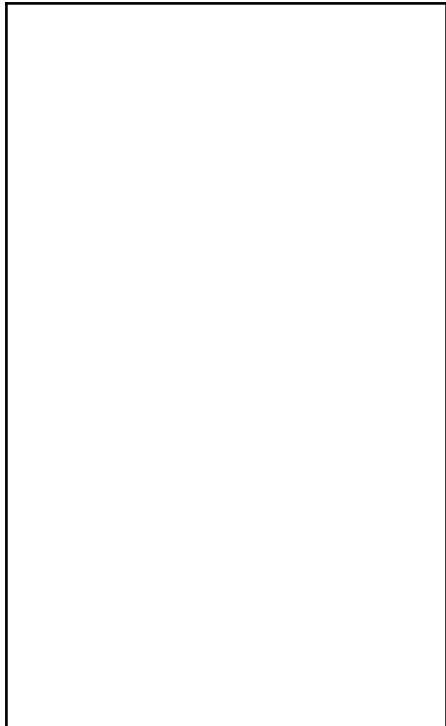

The event started with Ms. Akanksha Rawat welcoming the resource person of the day, **Dr. Irshad Ahmed Khan**.

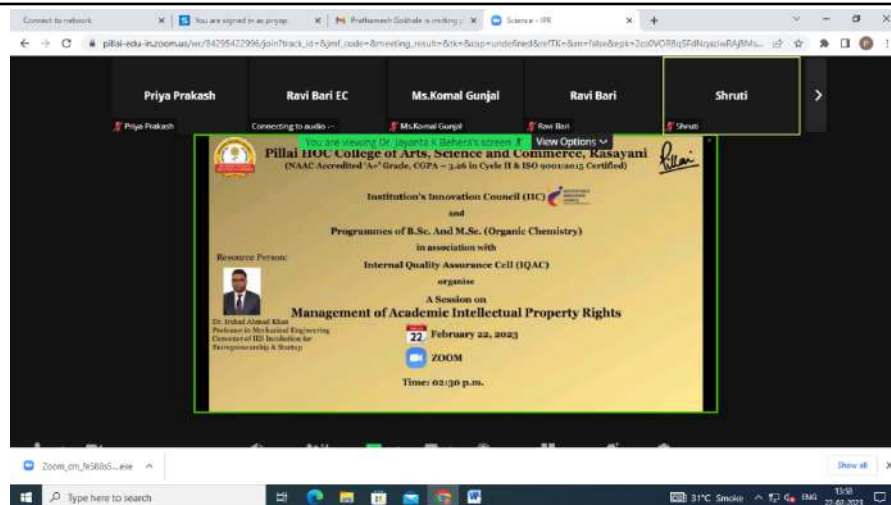
The objective of this event was to spread awareness about Intellectual Property Rights and to encourage staff for filing patents.

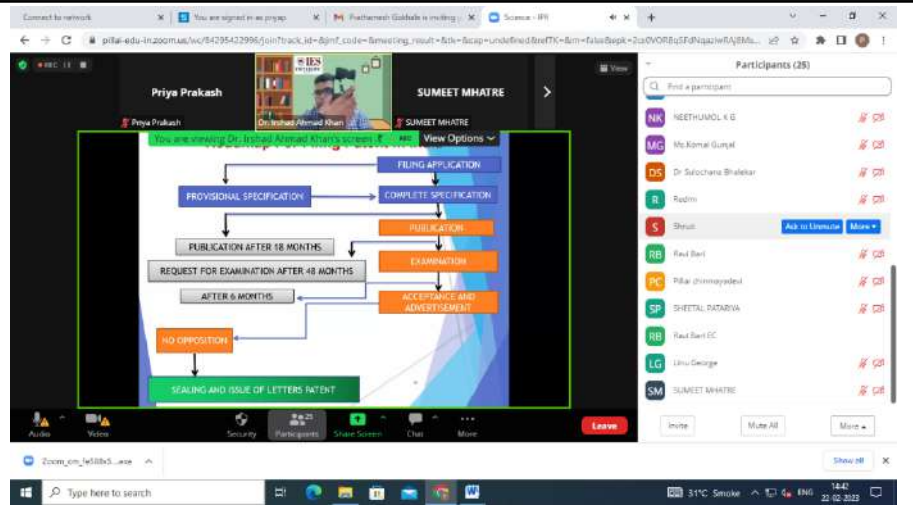



Its validity is interestingly 60 years after the author's passing. Academicians are very creative and have novel ideas, but sadly, they place less value on copyrights. On the other hand, businessmen understand how crucial copyrights are. If the author has presented the same idea differently than other people, such other presentations may also be protected by copyright. Copyright is an expression, not an idea." he said.
