1) Outreach Programme by Department of Arts Date: June 25, 2022

The **Department of Arts** in association with the **Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)** organized a visit to **Sheeshu Vikas High School** located at Mohopada as a part of its Social Outreach/ Extension program **on June 25, 2022.**

The objective of such activities is to reach out to the larger society and bring about a positive change in the lives of the people. As an educational institution, a major component of our Outreach activities is education along with raising awareness. We conducted activities for the children which fell under the age group 7 - 8 years.

Our students conducted various activities like yoga, physical exercise, and oratory competition to bridge the gap in services provided by official/governmental sources and non-profit organizations.

We periodically undertake such social outreach programs and document them, to spread awareness and share positive reinforcement in the society and amongst children.

The program ended with positive feedback by the principal and teachers of the school.







2)Lokmanya Ek Yuga - Movie Screening Date: July 02, 2022

The Film, Drama and Music Club and Faculty of Arts in association with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organized a movie screening – Lokmanya Ek Yuga Purush on July 02, 2022 between 1:00 pm to 3:30 pm. This was followed by an interactive session with the students on the process of making biographic movies

Lokmanya - Ek Yuga Purush is a Marathi biographic film written and directed by Om Raut an aspiring young director. Many times it was observed that students are acquainted with our history and culture which is only taught in schools and colleges. But there is very rigid information about the great kings, freedom fighters, and social reformers who have sacrificed their lives for our nation and strengthened the socioeconomics, and political roots of our nation.

As a part of creative teaching techniques, the main objective of the movie screening was to encourage students to watch a movie on one such social reformer and freedom fighter Lokmanya Tilak and attempt to give students to know more about the era and him through cinematic perspective. This will generate students more interest as movie screenings give visual experience and help to generate interest in the subjects. We also encouraged discussions among the students from various perspectives related to films and to bring students together to share experiences.

The movie was screened at Conclave II. Total 122 students participated in this activity. The event was a success with active participation and discussion among students. One of the objectives of encouraging students to watch films and learn something from it was achieved as the convenors received positive feedback from the participants.

Objective- The objective of the event is to understand how the speaker trained the mainstream actors like Alia Bhatt, Vijay Varma, and Shefali Shah and the different stages of their dialect training. He would also help the young cinephiles to understand cinema and how content is designed for a streaming platform.

Day 1: The film, Darlings, a major motion picture, produced by Red Chillies Productions, was screened in the Auditorium, 9th floor, PHCASC. After the screening, **Mr. Avinash Kunju** spoke at length about the film wanting women to punch past the abuse rather than negotiate with the scorpion, a euphemism used for the abusive husband in the film. He also spoke about the different perspectives shown on domestic violence and how it helps viewers process all situations.

Day 2: Amol spoke on the nuances of dialect coaching, the challenges he faced training actors of the pedigree of **Alia Bhatt, Vijay Varma, Shefali Shah and Roshan Mathew** to name a few. He singled out Roshan Mathew for special praise and how he managed to give time for the training while he was on set shooting for Kuruthi- a malayalam film. Selection of content for OTT platforms like Netflix, Amazon Prime were also discussed in detail. The session concluded with the Q & A session.

8) The Waste Land: An Epic of the Modern Age

Date: December 16 & 17, 2022

The English Literary Association and Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Pillai HOC College of Arts, Science and Commerce organised an event titled **The Waste Land**: **An Epic of the Modern Age** to mark the centenary celebrations of the publication of T. S. Eliot's magnum opus **The Waste Land** on the 16th and 17th December 2022.

The centenary celebrations began with the screening of two documentaries titled, "T.S. Eliot: An Introduction" and "The Waste Land." The first video gave insights on T.S. Eliot's professional and literary accomplishments whereas the second analysed the selected poems of T. S. Eliot especially "The Waste Land". The programme commenced at 11 a.m. The screening was followed by a discussion session wherein around 35 students from various classes took part and shared their views on the topic.

The second part of the programme was a recitation competition, the highlight of the two day event. Sixteen students from BA and BA MMC participated in the competition which was evaluated by Ms. Sahima S. and Ms. Ankita Surve (Assistant Professors, Dept of English, PHCASC). The participants recited the selected portions of the final section of the poem, "What the Thunder Said." The objectives of the programme were fulfilled with the conduction of the above mentioned programmes on December 16th & 17th, 2022.





9) Add-on course on New Literatures

Date: January 12, 2023

An Add-On Course on 'New Literatures' was introduced in the academic year 2022-23. The course consisted of five modules pertaining to various genres of literature such as poetry, drama, fiction, short fiction and film studies. Ms. Sahima S., Asst. Professor, Faculty of Arts took the inaugural session of course. Thirty five students from various classes of BA programme registered and attended the add- on course.

Mr. Sujith Babu S., Mr. Linu George and Ms. Ankita Surve took the sessions on various topics. The course was designed for thirty contact hours which was held offline. The course coordinators gave unit wise assignments after completing each module. The fifth module dealt with 'Film Studies'. Three movies produced in diverse socio-cultural and political milieu was screened and analysed. Satyajit Ray's epic work ' Pather Panchali' was screened on the last of the last day of the course.

An evaluation test was also conducted along with along with the periodical module wise assignments. Thirty five students participated in the examination which was held on March 08, 2023. An electronically generated certificate was distributed to all those who scored 40% marks in the test.





10) Visit to Museum

Date: 29 January 2023

Historia Clava (History Club) in association with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Pillai HOC College of Arts, Science, and Commerce, Rasayani successfully conducted a visit to Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Vastu Sangralaya and RBI Museum, Fort on January 29, 2023.

This visit was organized for the FY, SY, and TY BA students. A total of 17 students and 02 teachers participated in the same. The Head of the Department (History), Keekan Priyesh Raghavan, and another History faculty, Mr. Sudhir, accompanied the students. It was the first program held under the newly formed club. The idea behind organizing this event was to enrich students' experience and outlook toward applied history as a flourishing field.

The students first visited the RBI Museum at around 10:30 am, where they got a systematic idea of how the money got its shape and status after years of experimentation and circulation. The Money from ancient India till the present was what they learned in the process. They were also shown a twenty minutes video by the museum authorities to enhance the understanding of the student community. It had coins from Ancient, medieval, and modern India too.

After a sumptuous lunch, the caravan reached Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Vastu Sangralaya, formerly known as Prince Wales Museum at fifteen minutes walking distance from RBI Museum at Fort area in CST. The visit catered to the fields such as paintings, numismatics, epigraphy, weapons, natural history, photography, space, pottery, Egyptian artifacts, sculptures, and many more. They all departed for their home around 4:30 pm. Such was a learning experience that the students will carry with them those memories for the rest of their lives.





11) Meraki- Poem Writing Competition

Department of Information Technology


Date: June 15, 2022



Date: June 24, 2022 to June 29, 2022



















12. Poster Making Competition – Design Your Thoughts(Programmes of IT/CS/DS/MSc.IT)


19. Alumni Talk -Programme of B.Sc.

Date: April 21, 2023 to April 29, 2023



Approximately 17 students participated in the conference.







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
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

The session ended at 3:00 pm










12) Movie Screening titled 'Shakuntala Devi' to observe National Mathematics Day


