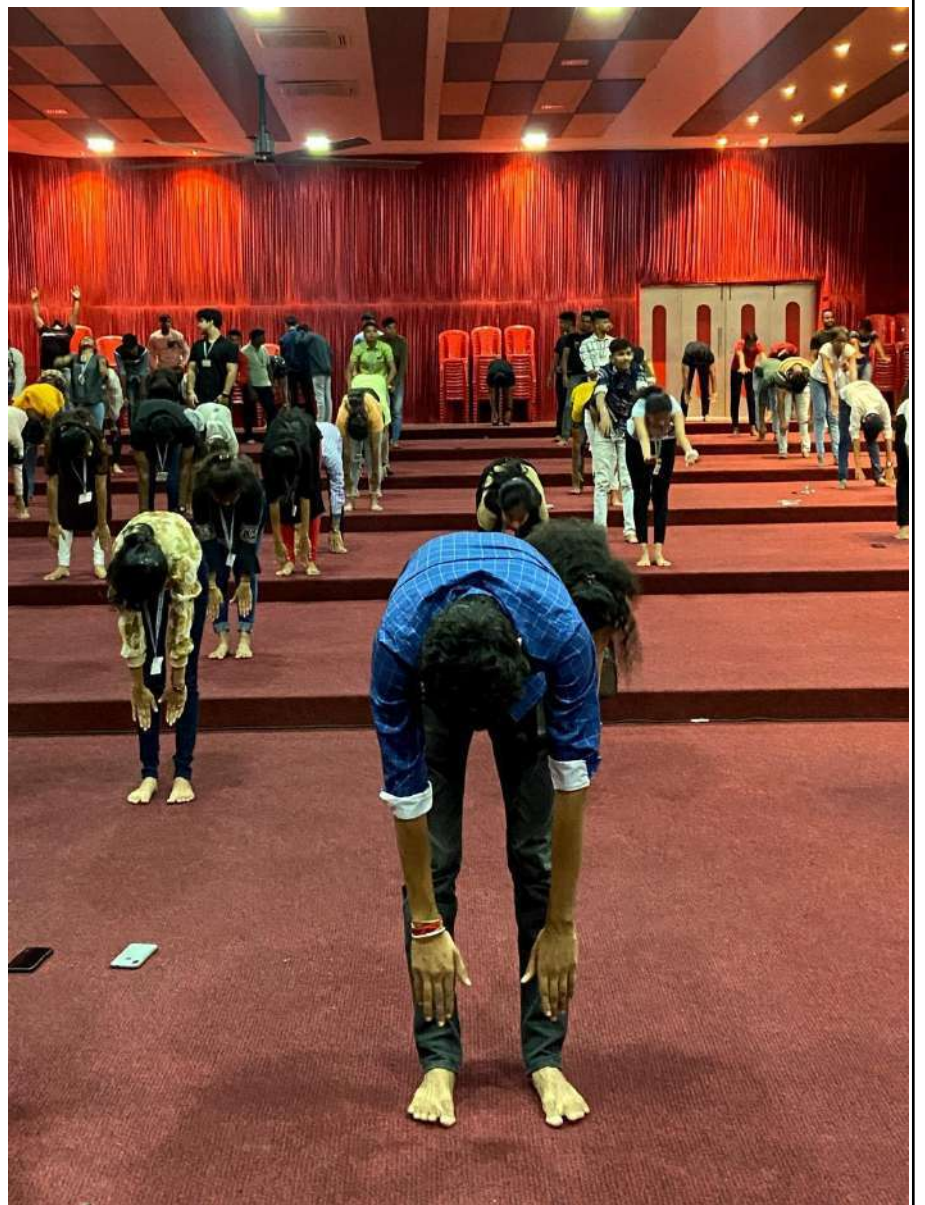

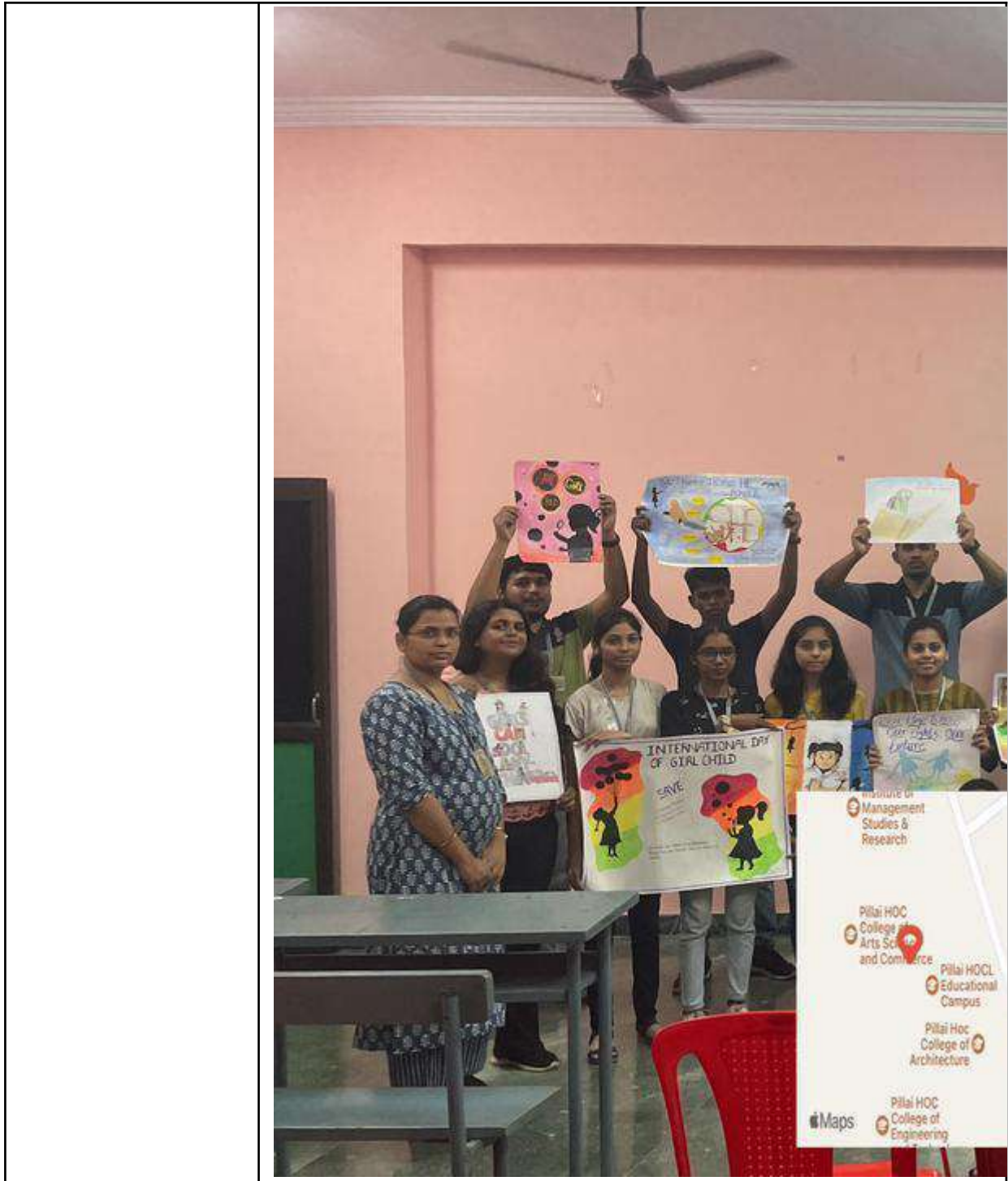
## Poster Making Competition
