The purpose of this report is to provide an overview of the successful completion of the Streamlit add-on course. Streamlit is a popular open-source Python library that

allows developers to create interactive web applications for data science and machine learning projects.

The programme started with an Orientation on August 23 in which students were briefed with all the topics they will be taught. The Streamlit add-on course was designed to enhance participants' skills in building interactive web applications using Streamlit. The course covered various topics including:

- UNIT 1 : Introduction to Streamlit - Sadiq Shaikh
- UNIT 2: Text Widgets of Streamlit - Sadiq Shaikh
- UNIT 3: Media Widgets of Streamlit - Anita Mhatre
- UNIT 4: Form Widgets of Streamlit-1 - Ketki Patil
- UNIT 5: Form Widgets of Streamlit-2 - Ashwini Lad
- UNIT 6: Advanced Widgets – Rutuja Madane
- UNIT 7: Creating a Mini Project Form - Sadiq Shaikh

A sum of 92 students participated in this course from FYDS (63) SYDS (23) and TYDS (06) in all the sessions. The course was attended by a group of enthusiastic learners including data scientists, machine learning engineers, and software developers. Participants had varying levels of experience with Python and data science but shared a common interest in expanding their knowledge of Streamlit.

This was a hybrid programme so some of the sessions were conducted online and mostly offline sessions were conducted. After each module faculty member use to provide assignments in which they have to code the task assigned and after the module submission were kept. The course spanned 36 hours, with interactive lectures conducted twice a week. Each session lasted for one-two hours, allowing ample time for hands-on exercises and Q&A sessions. After completion of the Course students were examined in which they have to code a sample website using Streamlit Python.

Throughout the course, participants gained practical experience in developing interactive web applications using Streamlit. Feedback from participants has been overwhelmingly positive, with many expressing appreciation for the hands-on approach and practical exercises. Participants found the course content comprehensive and well-structured, enabling them to quickly grasp the concepts and apply them in their projects.

In conclusion, the successful completion of the "Streamlit – A Faster Way to Build Web Apps" Add-on Programme has equipped participants with the knowledge and skills to develop interactive web applications for their data science and machine learning projects. After successfully clearing the exam students were awarded with soft copy certificate. The practical experience gained during the course will undoubtedly prove invaluable in their professional endeavours, enabling them to create impactful and user-friendly applications using Streamlit.
