Valedictory Ceremony:

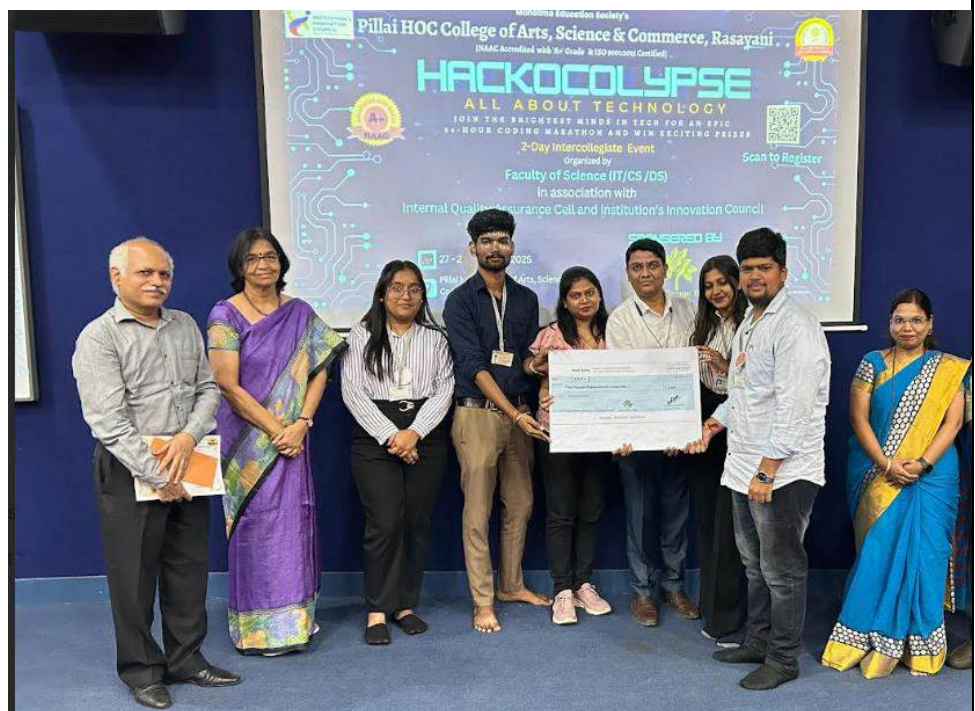
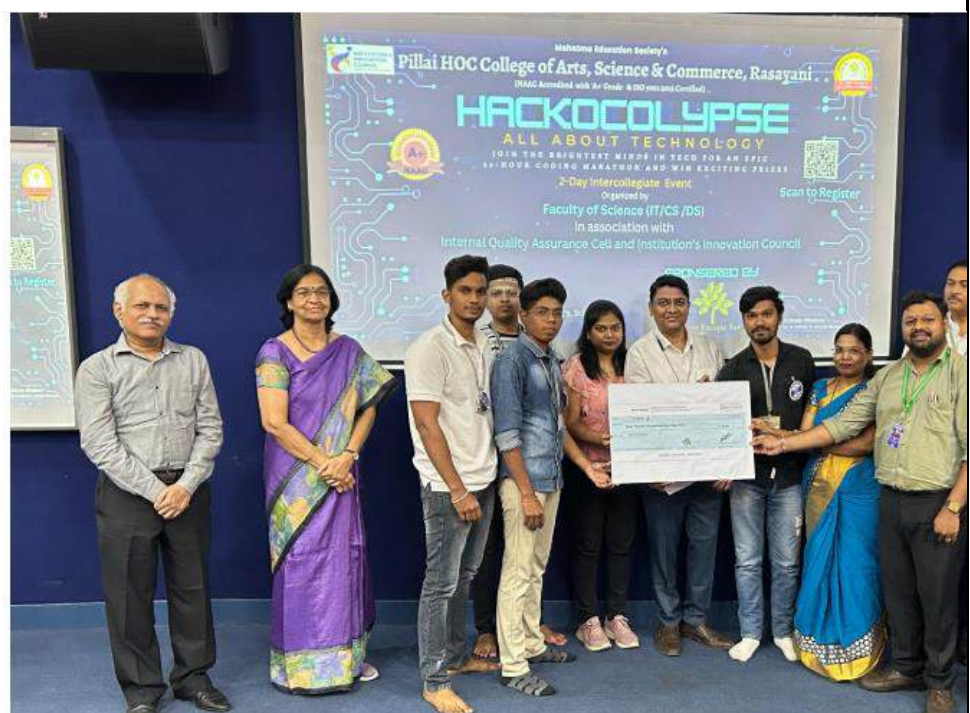
