The objectives of the seminar were : 1. To spread awareness about menstrual health and hygiene. 2. To promote sustainable and eco-friendly menstrual practices. 3. To break social taboos and encourage open dialogue on menstruation. 4. To empower students with correct knowledge and resources for better health management. The seminar began with a warm welcome extended to the participants, followed by an introduction of the distinguished resource person, Ms. Vinitha Rajendran. She opened the session by acknowledging the importance of addressing menstrual hygiene as not just a health concern, but also as a matter of dignity and equality.
